<p><u>DESCRIPTION:</u></p> <p>Camping on a commercial site or recognised camp site having toilets, a shop and/or other facilities.</p> <p>Semi permanent standing camps e.g. Scout and Guide facilities.</p> <p>When camping on own establishment sites.</p>
<p><u>QUALIFICATIONS:</u></p> <p>The leader should have considerable experience of the type of camping involved and should have attended a recognised training course such as BEL.</p> <p>Be familiar with the equipment to be used and the associated safety measures</p> <p>Be thoroughly familiar with the area to which they are going and the sites to be used.</p>
<p><u>STAFFING RATIO:</u></p> <p>2 / 12</p>
<p><u>PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:</u></p> <p>Warm clothing, wind / water resistance outer clothing, and appropriate footwear.</p>
<p><u>HAZARDS:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Burns from cooking stoves when cooking or re-fuelling stoves. • Tent fires. • Injuries sustained from tripping over ropes especially at night time.
<p><u>GUIDANCE:</u></p> <p>Teachers and instructors must be appropriately trained in the use of Trangia and other cooking stoves. Cooking should not take place inside a tent. Re-fuelling stoves should not be done inside a tent or a confined space.</p>
