<p><b><u>DESCRIPTION:</u></b></p> <p>This is an AALA in scope activity</p> <p>Remote standing camps that have reasonable access to emergency services and ready access to the nearest road. The road should not be more than 2 kilometres from the site.</p> <p>Camping in places which are more remote than the above or that are in naturally hazardous terrain eg high level camping in mountain areas.</p>
<p><b><u>QUALIFICATIONS:</u></b></p> <p>The leader should have a recognised qualification such as the BEL award, the Walking Group Leaders Award or the Mountain Leaders Award depending on the level of camp.</p>
<p><b><u>STAFFING RATIO:</u></b></p> <p>There should be a minimum ratio of 2 / 10 and a maximum party size of 12 including the two staff. It may be advisable to reduce the participant numbers in some circumstances</p>
<p><b><u>PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:</u></b></p> <p>Warm clothing, wind and waterproof outer clothing, and appropriate footwear.</p>
<p><b><u>HAZARDS:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hypothermia</li> <li>• Burns from cooking stoves when cooking or re-fuelling stoves.</li> <li>• Tent fires.</li> <li>• Slips and falls</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>GUIDANCE:</u></b></p> <p>Specific approval from Bracknell Forest Council should be obtained via the online approval system.</p>
