<p><u>DESCRIPTION:</u></p> <p>Coarse fishing and fly fishing from the bank only.</p>										
<p><u>QUALIFICATION:</u></p> <p>The instructor / supervisor must be an experienced in the type of fishing undertaken, be a strong swimmer and have an appropriate level of qualification in first aid, including resuscitation. Leaders should also have knowledge of responsible and sustainable angling practices, and of the waters being fished.</p>
