DIY Guide Guidance for School Governors

Governing Body – Corporate Responsibility

- 1. Authority rests with the whole governing body not with individual governors.
- 2. Collective responsibility must be taken for all the decisions of the Governing Body including those delegated to an individual (e.g. the Headteacher / Chair) or committee.
- 3. How individual governors vote, is confidential to the governing body and not recorded in minutes.
- 4. The chair can act on behalf of the governing body in exceptional circumstances, but must inform the whole governing body at the earliest opportunity.

Staff and parent governors:

- do *not* have to try to represent the views of the groups that elect them. They are *representative* staff / parents rather than representatives *of* staff / parents.
- when decisions have to be made by the governing body, each governor is free to vote in accordance with his/her own views.
