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<p><u>DESCRIPTION:</u></p> <p>Descending an artificial slopes or a slope that is covered with snow while standing on a board attached to a rider's feet.</p>
<p><u>QUALIFICATIONS:</u></p> <p>The instructor in charge must have a nationally recognised instructor's award for skiing and/or snowboarding which is recognised by the country that the activity is being undertaken.</p>
<p><u>STAFFING RATIO:</u></p> <p>1 / 12</p>
<p><u>PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:</u></p> <p>Warm clothing, water and wind resistant clothing, gloves, goggles and hard shell protective headwear.</p>
<p><u>HAZARDS:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Weather conditions • Hyperthermia • Injuries sustained from slips and falls
<p><u>GUIDANCE:</u></p> <p>This activity must be supervised by an instructor at all times. Participants should not be allowed to "free snowboard".</p>
